



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Check in and Check out

Q: When can I check in?

If you are camping, you can check in from 1pm. If you are glamping, check-in is from 3pm.

Q: When do I have to check out by?

Check out time is 11am.

Q: Can we check in earlier/ leave later?

Early arrivals and late departures may be available for your pitch depending on availability. These cost £5 per pitch. Please contact the office for more information.

Fire pits & BBQ's

Q: Can we reserve a fire pit?

Fire pits are hired out on a first-come first-served basis upon check-in. We do not reserve fire pits in advance of check-in.

Q: Can we bring our own fire pit and wood?

We do not allow you to bring your own fire pit and ask that only wood sold on site is burnt. The burning of other wood will lead to the confiscation of the fire pit.

Q: Can we have a BBQ?

We do allow BBQ's, we just ask that these are raised off the ground so as to protect the grass. We have some old shopping baskets which may be upturned and used to raise BBQ's off the ground.

Making a booking

Q: Can we pitch next to our friends?

Should you like to pitch near your friends, please make this known at the time of booking. When booking online this can be done through making a note in the available box. Although we cannot guarantee that we will be able to fulfil your request, we always try our best to accommodate groups who want to pitch together. If staying in the River Field you will be able to choose where you would like to pitch and so it's up to you where you and your friends go!

Q: How do I book for a group?

At Masons we welcome family groups and groups with children. Group bookings will be subject to a £40 deposit per pitch at check in.

Either each member of a party may book individually, or one party member may book and pay for all pitches. If booking online you will need to make multiple separate bookings for multiple pitches.

Q: Can we have electric hook-up?

All our pitches in our main field have electric hook-up. Our River Field is non-electric.



Q: Do you have any seasonal pitches?

We do not have any seasonal pitches at Masons. Our site is open from either Easter weekend or the first weekend in April (whichever comes first), until Halloween.

Q: Can we pitch in the river field?

Our non-electric river field is open 28 days a year on Friday and Saturday nights throughout the summer. Should you like to book in the river field, please specify at the time of booking. We only accept tents and small (VW sized) campervans in the River Field.

Q: Do you accept dogs?

At Masons we love dogs as long as they are kept on leads so that our free-range hens and the local livestock are safe. Dogs are charged at £2 per night each.

On Site

Q: Where is the office?

The office (and our on-site shop) is located inside the vintage airstream caravan on your right as you enter the site. Please check in here. The office opens at 8:30 am, and from Sunday to Thursday, closes at 5:30pm.

Q: Do you have any laundry facilities?

Our laundry facilities are located around the back of our toilet block. The machines are coin operated and accept £1 coins.

Q: When is Masons' Coffee and Bread Shed open?

Our Coffee and Bread Shed opens at 8:30 am selling freshly baked pastries, sourdough baguettes, coffee and tea. We ask that bread and pastry orders are placed the evening before, either in the office or the coffee shop itself.

Q: Where is the nearest supermarket/ big shop?

The nearest large shop is the Spa petrol station in Threshfield (a fifteen minute drive away). In Grassington (15 minutes by car) there is a smaller Spa. In Skipton (twenty minutes by car) there are two supermarkets, Morrisons and Tesco.

Q: Where is the river?

The river Wharfe is located at the bottom of the campsite. There is access at the bottom of the site straight onto the river-side path.

Q: Can we swim in the river?

Shortly downstream from the campsite is a popular wild-swimming spot. We strongly advise that children are supervised at all times when playing in or near the river.

Q: We forgot our airbed/electric hook-up lead. Can we borrow one from you?

We hire out items from £10 per item. We also ask for a £30 deposit which is returned to you upon us receiving the item back.
